## FAMILY NOTES

**Marriage (19 January 1891):** The two witnesses were Ludwig Kruger and Wilhelm Rudiger. Family tradition states that Brunis cared for her mother until she died; then she married Julius. The couple's marriage record proves this to be a false legend. That being said, Brunis's mother did die just three months after the marriage.

**Residence (fam) (1892):** The emigration record from Hamburg gives Julius' residence as "Kleczewo, Russland".

**Residence (fam) (2 February 1892):** Julius (25) was a witness to the birth of his half-brother Ferdinand's daughter Emilia.

**Census (fam) (4 June 1900):** In the household are: Julius (33), Pavronesrivr (40), Ellen (8), Arthur (2), and two boarders, David Powell

and Fred Koch.

**Census (fam) (1 June 1905):** In the household are: Julius (38), Brunislava (40), Helen (10), Arthur (7), Arnold (5), Gertrude (3), and Liddie (2/12).

**Census (fam) (26 April 1910):** In the household are: Julius (43), Blanche (50), Arthur (12), Ewald (9), Gertrude (8), Lydia (4) and Edward (3).

#### FATHER NOTES: Julius Paul

**Birth (19 May 1867):** Sławoszewek is a small village about 3km northeast of Kleczew. Kleczew is the town Julius gave as his place of residence when he emigrated in 1892. His 1942 newspaper obituary gives the correct birthdate of 19 May 1867.

**Baptism (19 May 1867):** Julius' godparents were Władysław Rożanski and Anna Rozyna Splett née Kriger (married 1844 in Babiak parish). He was baptized by Otto Hinz, the pastor of the Evangelical parish in Konin.

**Residence (19 January 1891):** Bronislawa was living with her mother in Alinowo at the time of her marriage.

**Residence (1892):** New York is listed as Julius' destination.

**Occupation (2 February 1892):** Julius is described as a "поденщик" in his niece Emilia's birth record.

**Emigration (29 April 1892):** Julius sailed from Hamburg to West Hartlepool on the British flag steamship "British Queen". The ship's manifest records Julius as age 26. He is in a list of persons whose destination is "North America via Liverpool". Julius' specific destination is New York.

**Immigration (19 May 1892):** Julius sailed on the "Wisconsin" from Liverpool and Queenstown (Cobh), Ireland before landing in New York. New York is listed as his destination. On the ship were three members of the Krüger family: Ludwig (53); Carl (30); and Ludwig (16). The older Ludwig is almost surely the same man who was a witness at Julius' wedding the previous year.

**Residence (1895):** When Brunis immigrated to America, the ship's manifest listed her destination as "to Julius Paul #3208 Fox St., Chicago". According to the 1900 US Census, this is a two-apartment dwelling.

**Occupation (1896–1902):** 1900 census gives occupation of Julius Paul as "labor steelmills". During 1900 Julius was unemployed for 4 months.

**Residence (1899–1900):** According to the 1900 census, this address was a four-plex.

**Residence (1902–1940):** Julius purchased 80 acres of land in Neva Township on 20 October 1901 from Annie A. Leslie and T. W. Leslie, her husband, for \$1300. The land was located on "The west half (1/2) of the north west quarter (1/4) of Section number twenty-four (24) Township number thirty-two (32) north of Range number eleven (11) East".

Sometime later, Julius purchased another 40 acres adjacent to the original parcel on the south side, south of County Road O.

Clarence Behm: "they bought a 160 acre farm about 10 miles north of Antigo, Wisconsin, with a log cabin on the property. They lived in the log cabin until about 1918, when they built a new two-story house with a log-burning furnace."

**Residence (1 April 1935):** Julius was living in the same house in 1940 as in 1935.

**Census (10 May 1940):** Julius was living next door to his son Arthur and family. He was renting his home and paid \$4 per month.

**Residence (1942):** Julius was living in a hotel in Antigo on city funds when he died.

**Death (10 October 1942):** Julius' newspaper obituary reads in part: "Julius Paul, 75, town of Neva farmer who has made his home in the city for the past two years, died Saturday at 2 p.m. after a long illness." According to his Death Register, Julius died of "carcinoma of lung; chronic myocarditis due to chronic nephritis; arterio sclerosis".

**Burial (13 October 1942):** Lot E4-034. "Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Peace Lutheran church with the Rev. Arthur Fergin officiating, and interment will be in Elmwood cemetery. Friends may call at the McCandless & Zobel funeral home."

"Pallbearers were Orval Polzin, Ed Buboltz, William Wagner, Adolph Wiegert, Albert Buboltz and Gust Schmidt. Coming from out of town for the funeral were Mr. and Mrs. Ed Paul and children of Wauwatosa; Mrs. Carl Krueger, Chicago; Mr. and Mrs. Ewald Paul and children of Beaver Dam and Norma and Clement Krueger of Chicago."

**Education:** In the 1940 census, Julius reported his highest grade of school completed as "0". He is described as "illiterate" in his marriage record.

**General:** The 1900 census states that Julius's parents were also born in Poland.

#### MOTHER NOTES: Bronislawa Rottke

**Baptism (8 April 1860):** Bronislawa's godparents were Adam Szrejber and Julianna Gabler. She was almost certainly baptized in the evangelical (i.e. Lutheran) church in Zagórow.

**Residence (19 January 1891):** Living with her mother.

**Residence (1895):** Milaczew is a small village located about three miles northwest of Kleczew, Poland.

**Emigration (25 June 1895):** Destined for Philadelphia upon the ship Markomania; accompanied by daughter Helene Paul and Bertha Henkelmann; all three originated from "Milaczew, Russ."

There is a birth record for a Berta Henkelman in Konin parish, 1880 No. 3, daughter of Friedrich Gottfried Henkelman and his wife Wilhelmina (Fisher? The name seems to be Fidcher in Cyrillic). There is no mention of a witness named Paul or Rottke, nor is Wilhelmina's maiden name Paul or Rottke.

**Immigration (13 July 1895):** Arrived with daughter Helene Paul and Bertha Henkelmann (Julius listed as Bertha's "brother-in-law"). Arrived with \$3 (the word "nothing" is crossed out and replaced with "\$3.00"). Final destination is Julius Paul, 3208 Fox St., Chicago, IL. 81 passengers.

Bertha may have been related by marriage to Julius' first cousin Adolf Haase. Adolf married Justyna Henkelmann, daughter of Jan Henkelmann and Karolina Sander.

**Death (20 April 1928):** Cause of death as recorded in Brunis' Death Register: "suicide - cut throat with razor"; had an operation on 18 April to repair self-inflicted wound, died 2 days later.

**Burial (23 April 1928):** Lot E4-034 . "Funeral services will be held from the William Behm home, 1226 Arctic Street at 1:30 o'clock Monday afternoon and from St. Matthew's church at Deerbrook at two o'clock, the Rev. Martin Schneider of Deerbrook will officiate. Burial will be in Elmwood cemetery." Brunis' name is spelled "Brunice" on her headstone.
